DEFINITION

Technique that based on the use of the qualities of the horse and used in a perspective of comprehensive rehabilitation of the individual, harmoniously integrates elements linked to the areas of health, education and riding.



The walking of the horse produces in the patient a three-dimensional movement similar to human walking.



The affective bond that is generated between both, produces that the therapeutic interventions reach the maximum value and capacity of progression.



The main thing in the therapeutic intervention is to provide the patient and his family with support, security, trust and family support for the positive results of the process.


